Corneo Director - Sheraz Daya

The corneo plastic unit has three consultants and offers a total of four fellowship training posts.

Two pre-consultant fellowships are available in Cornea, external disease and refractive surgery, with the purpose of improving diagnostic skill, decision making process and surgical acumen.

The programme includes the diagnosis and medical management of diseases of the lids, conjunctiva, cornea/sclera and anterior ocular segment, as well as recognition and treatment of posterior segment disease that may affect the anterior segment; surgery of the conjunctiva, cornea/sclera, anterior segment, lens, and anterior vitreous, with special emphasis on corneal transplantation and related procedures; principles and practice of keratorefractive surgery; principles of contact lens fitting and management of complications of contact lens wear.

Oculoplastics Preceptor - Raman Malhotra

Two fellowships in oculoplastic, lacrimal and orbital surgery are available for experienced ophthalmologists who are at pre-consultant level or close to the end of their training.

A Fellowship from the Royal College of Ophthalmologists, Royal College of Surgeons, or equivalent, is desirable. GMC Registration must be obtained or feasible. An integral part of the fellowship will be taking part in complex multidisciplinary orbito-facial surgery with Maxillofacial and Plastic Surgery. A comprehensive training in Oculoplastic, Orbital and lacrimal surgery is provided with opportunities for clinical research.

The fellowship will provide a broad training in oculoplastic, orbital and lacrimal surgery. In addition there are opportunities for exposure to Corneal and refractive surgery, Plastic and Maxillofacial surgery, Burns Management and Mohs surgery. The Oculoplastic Fellow will be expected to attend the interdisciplinary F.A.C.E. (Facial Anomalies Clinic at East Grinstead) clinic and operating lists, as well as work closely with the Maxillofacial + Plastic Surgery and Burns Departments.
